



Reims



De La Salle was born and raised here and it is where his family had lived for generations. It became the primary cultural influence in his life and the place where his vocation found its beginnings.

Brouillet



Name of De La Salle's maternal grandparents, the Moëts. As a boy, he visited his grandparents during the summers—and it was his grandfather who helped him learn how to recite the divine office every day.

Liesse



Location where De La Salle and the Brothers took their first vows; they made the pilgrimage to Liesse, walking all through the night.

Rouen



De La Salle established the center of his Institute here, founded unique educational ventures at Saint Yon, and spent his last years here, dying in the Brothers' community on April 7, 1719.

Paris



Where De La Salle and the first Brothers came in 1688 and demonstrated that their ministry reached beyond the confines of the diocese of Reims.
