RESPONSE

Leader: We call out to God over and over.

All: And God calls out to us as well.

**Leader: God calls on the most ordinary of people to
perform extraordinary tasks.**

**All: We recall that God called Abraham, Moses, Jonah,
David, Mary and the Apostles.**

Leader: God keeps on calling people like you and me.

**All: Some times God has to call us over and over
before we hear the call.**

Some times we resist answering the call.

**Leader: God never gives up. God never loses patience
with us.**

**All: Some times God calls to our heart and to no one
else hears it but us, and sometimes God calls us**

through someone else and we do not realize that God is calling us.

Leader: Jesus has called us to be His disciples, His followers – to be CHRISTIANS.

All: We come to realize that the Lord calls us to specific tasks and particular places. We are called for specific reasons and blessed by God for each endeavor.

Leader: May the Spirit of God make us open to God's call.

Leader: The Spirit of God rests upon me.
The Spirit of God consecrates me;
The Spirit of God bids me go forth
to proclaim His peace and His joy.

SCRIPTURE

There are different kinds of spiritual gifts but the same Spirit; there are different forms of service but the same Lord; there are different workings but the same God Who produces all of them in everyone. To each individual the manifestation of the Spirit is given for some benefit. To one is given through the Spirit the expression of wisdom; to another the expression of knowledge according to the same Spirit; to another faith by the same Spirit; to another gifts of healing by the one Spirit; to another mighty deeds; to another prophecy; to another discernment of spirits; to another varieties of tongues; to another interpretation of tongues. But one and the same Spirit produces all of these, distributing them individually to each person as He wishes. As a body is one though it has many parts, and all the parts of the body, though many, are one body, so also Christ. For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, slaves or free persons, and we were all given to drink of one Spirit.
