Hebrews 4: 14 -16; 5: 7 – 9

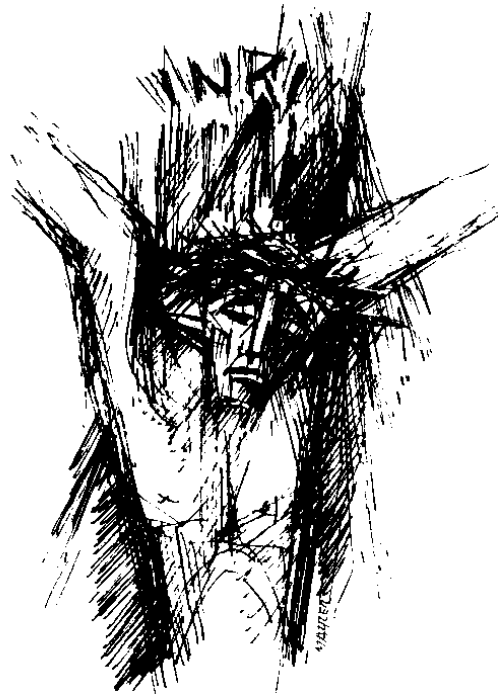
We have a great high priest

The Seven Last Words of Christ on the Cross

“Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do.”

Luke 23:33-35 And when they were come to the place, which is called Calvary, there they crucified Him, and the malefactors, one on the right hand, and the other on the left. Then Jesus said, Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do. And they divided His garment, and cast lots. And the people stood looking on. And the rulers also with them derided Him, saying, He saved others; let Him save Himself, if He be Christ, the Chosen of God.

“Today thou shalt be with Me in paradise.”

Luke 23:39-43 And one of the thieves which was hanged with Him taunted Him, saying, If You are the Christ, save Yourself and us.

But the other answering rebuked him, saying, Do you not fear God, seeing you have the same condemnation?

And we indeed justly; for we receive the due reward of our deeds: but this man has done nothing wrong.

And he said to Jesus, Lord, remember me when You come into Your kingdom.

And Jesus said to him, I tell you, Today you shall be with Me in paradise.

“Woman, behold your son, son behold your mother.”

John 19:25-27 Now there stood by the cross of Jesus His mother, and His mother’s sister, Mary the wife of Cleophas, and Mary Magdalene.

When Jesus therefore saw His mother, and the disciple standing by, whom He loved, He said to His mother, Woman, behold your son!

Then He said to the disciple, Behold your mother! And from that hour the disciple took her unto his own home.

“My God, my God, why have You forsaken Me?”

Matt. 27:45-47 Now from the sixth hour there was darkness over all the land unto the ninth hour. And about the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani? that is to say, My God, my God, why have You forsaken Me? Some of them that stood there, when they heard that, said, This man is calling for Elias.

“I thirst.”

John 19:28-29 After this, Jesus knowing that all things were now accomplished, that the scripture might be fulfilled, said, “I thirst.”

Now there was a vessel full of vinegar nearby: and they filled a sponge with vinegar, and put it upon hyssop, and put it to His mouth.

“It is finished.”

John 19:30 When Jesus therefore had received the vinegar, He said, “It is finished:” and He bowed His head, and gave up His spirit.

Luke 23:45-46 And the sun was darkened, and the veil of the temple was torn in two. And Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying, “Father, into Your hands I commend My spirit.”
